



Northern Night Cup – Culbin Wed 9th Feb 2022

Final Details

General points to note:

- Parking, toilets and Registration (dibber and **map pick up**) at Welhill Car Park - IV36 2TG is the nearest postcode; brown signs from A96 at Brodie and west of River Findhorn bridge. Please note there is a charge for parking unless you have a FLS permit. £1.50 / 3hours
- Under 14s **MUST** be accompanied by an adult.
- Registration opens at 1730, starts 1800 -1845.
- Please respect other users of the forest and maintain 1m social distancing while on the course, at registration, the start and download.
- There are no changes to entries on the day. If you have a problem eg wrong dibber number then Registration will record it for adjustment post-event.
- **MAPS AND HIRED DIBBERS TO BE COLLECTED FROM REGISTRATION** (no maps available at the start).
- Hired dibbers should be left in the drop box at **DOWNLOAD** afterwards.
- **DOWNLOAD** will be a punch of the dibber in the download box until it beeps; there will be **NO** splits/results/queries.
- SIAir is **NOT** enabled; you **MUST PUNCH** the controls

Course Notes

- **SAFETY BEARING** is **SOUTH** to a main track (then west for Controls 1- 12, east for 13 to finish) . You must report to download even if you do not finish your course.
- **START** is adjacent to the Car Park. Please do not arrive at the start more than 5 minutes before your start time.
- 100m from the **FINISH** to download.
- Final course details: Long 4.4km, Short 3.5 km. Map scale 1:7500, 2.5m contours

Safety Notes

- All participants take part at their own risk.
- You **must** carry a spare torch /battery and are advised to carry a whistle.
- You **MUST** report to download by **the 8pm course close time**. It is 100m from Finish to assembly. Course closing time and planner's emergency number written on the map
- Participants are advised to notify the Organiser of any relevant medical conditions – leave an envelope with Organiser which will be destroyed if not collected.
- By entering the event you have agreed to abide by the British Orienteering Federation Code of Conduct in respect of COVID-19 and should maintain social distancing even when out on the courses. Those with COVID-19, who are self-isolating or have COVID-19 symptoms, must not attend the event.
